
*Dear Ambassador Mosbacher,*

I share your disappointment and surprise at hearing the news that member of the Sejm Janusz Szewczak in his recent interview raised the issue of reparations, amounting to \$900 billion, from Germany for World War II. I assure you that neither the Institute of National Remembrance nor the Government of Poland have anything to do with the unauthorized statement of Mr. Szewczak. Understanding that his actions undermine the agreements we have with you on conducting a coherent information campaign, the IPN makes every effort to mitigate the damage from the untimely statements of Mr. Szewczak and to prevent the news topic from gaining momentum.

Considering the developments, I suggest that we revert to the initial plan to lay the issue of reparations before the United Nations Security Council. I am sure the resolution, urging Germany to restore historical justice and pay adequate compensation to Poland, will make our campaign much more fruitful, especially if the United States supports the resolution.

I kindly request you to consider the IPN's proposal and I hope the incident will not have any effect on our long-standing effective cooperation.
